
5. Fuel Filter

A: REMOVAL

1) Release fuel pressure. <Ref. to 2-8 [W1A0].>



- 2) Disconnect fuel hoses from fuel filter.
- 3) Remove filter from holder.


B: INSPECTION

- 1) Check the inside of fuel filter for dirt and water sediment.
- 2) If it is clogged, or if replacement interval has been reached, replace it.
- 3) If water is found in it, shake and expel the water from inlet port.

C: INSTALLATION

CAUTION:

- If fuel hoses are damaged at the connecting portion, replace it with a new one.
- If clamps are badly damaged, replace with new ones.



- 1) Installation is in the reverse order of removal.
- 2) Tighten hose clamp screws.

Tightening torque:

1.0 — 1.5 N·m (0.1 — 0.15 kg-m, 0.7 — 1.1 ft-lb)
