
16.Camshaft Sprocket

A: REMOVAL


- 1) Remove the V-belt. <Ref. to ME(STi)-41, RE-MOVAL, V-belt.>
- 2) Remove the crankshaft pulley. <Ref. to ME(STi)-44, REMOVAL, Crankshaft Pulley.>
- 3) Remove the timing belt cover. <Ref. to ME(STi)-45, REMOVAL, Timing Belt Cover.>
- 4) Remove the timing belt assembly. <Ref. to ME(STi)-46, REMOVAL, Timing Belt Assembly.>
- 5) Remove the camshaft sprockets. To lock the camshaft, use ST.

B: INSTALLATION


1) Install the camshaft sprocket. To lock the camshaft, use ST.

NOTE:

Do not confuse camshaft sprockets (RH) and (LH) during installation.


Tightening torque: 98 N⋅m (10 kgf-m, 72.4 ft-lb)

Tightening torque:

29.5 N·m (3.0 kgf-m, 21.8 ft-lb), and then tighen 45° furthermore



- 2) Install the timing belt assembly. <Ref. to ME(STi)-48, INSTALLATION, Timing Belt Assembly.>
- 3) Install the timing belt cover. <Ref. to ME(STi)-45, INSTALLATION, Timing Belt Cover.>
- 4) Install the crankshaft pulley. <Ref. to ME(STi)-44, INSTALLATION, Crankshaft Pulley.>
- 5) Install the V-belt. <Ref. to ME(STi)-41, INSTALLATION, V-belt.>

C: INSPECTION

- 1) Check the sprocket teeth for abnormal wear and scratches.
- 2) Make sure there is no free play between sprocket and key.
- 3) Check the crankshaft sprocket notch used for sensor for damage and contamination of foreign matter.
