
# 4. Muffler

# A: REMOVAL

1) Separate muffler from rear exhaust pipe.

# **CAUTION:**

Be careful, exhaust pipe is hot.



2) Remove left and right rubber cushions.


# **CAUTION:**

Be careful not to drop the muffler during removal.

### NOTE:

To facilitate removal, apply a coat of SUBARU CRC to mating area of rubber cushions in advance.




3) Remove front rubber cushion, and detach muffler assembly.

### NOTE:

To facilitate removal, apply a coat of SUBARU CRC to mating area of rubber cushion in advance.

### **B: INSTALLATION**


Install in the reverse order of removal.

### NOTE

Replace gasket and self-lock nut with a new one.

## Tightening torque:

48 N·m (4.9 kgf-m, 35.4 ft-lb)



### C: INSPECTION

- 1) Make sure there are no exhaust leaks from connections and welds.
- 2) Make sure there are no holes or rusting.
- 3) Make sure the cushion rubber is not worn or cracked.
