
32. Fuel Bypass Valve

A: REMOVAL


- 1) Release the fuel pressure.
- <Ref. to FU(H4DOTC)-43, RELEASING OF FUEL PRESSURE, PROCEDURE, Fuel.>
- 2) In the engine compartment, disconnect the fuel delivery hoses, return hoses and evaporation hoses.
 - (1) Disconnect the quick connector on the fuel delivery line and return line by pushing the ST in the direction of the arrow.
- ST 42099AE000 CONNECTOR REMOVER
 (2) Remove the clip and disconnect the evaporation hose from the pipe.

WARNING:

- · Be careful not to spill fuel.
- Catch the fuel from hoses using a container or cloth.

- 3) Remove the fuel by-pass valve from the vehicle.

- 4) Disconnect the fuel delivery hose and fuel return hose from the fuel by-pass valve.


B: INSTALLATION

Install in the reverse order of removal.

Tightening torque:

Fuel by-pass valve bracket 7.5 N⋅m (0.76 kgf-m, 5.5 ft-lb) Clamp

1.25 N·m (0.13 kgf-m, 5.5 ft-lb)
