

16.Cam Sprocket

A: REMOVAL

- 1) Remove the crank pulley. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-
- 41, REMOVAL, Crank Pulley.>
- 2) Remove the front chain cover. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-42, REMOVAL, Front Chain Cover.>
- 3) Remove the timing chain assembly.
- <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-44, REMOVAL, Timing Chain Assembly.>
- 4) Remove the cam sprocket. To lock the camshaft, use the ST.

B: INSTALLATION

1) Install the cam sprocket. To lock the camshaft, use the ST.

Tightening torque:

29.5 N⋅m (3.0 kgf-m, 21.8 ft-lb)

2) Further tighten the bolt.





- 4) Install the front chain cover.
- <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-42, INSTALLATION, Front Chain Cover.>
- 5) Install the crank pulley. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-41, INSTALLATION, Crank Pulley.>

C: INSPECTION

- 1) Check the cam sprocket teeth for abnormal wear and scratches.
- 2) Make sure there is no free play between cam sprocket and key.
