
17. Crank Sprocket


A: REMOVAL

- 1) Remove the crank pulley. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-
- 41, REMOVAL, Crank Pulley.>
- 2) Remove the front chain cover. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-42, REMOVAL, Front Chain Cover.>
- 3) Remove the timing chain assembly.
- <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-44, REMOVAL, Timing Chain Assembly.>
- 4) Remove the cam sprocket. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-
- 49, REMOVAL, Cam Sprocket.>
- 5) Remove the crank sprocket (A).



B: INSTALLATION

1) Install the crank sprocket (A).



- 2) Install the cam sprocket. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-49, INSTALLATION, Cam Sprocket.>
- 3) Install the timing chain assembly.
- <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-45, INSTALLATION, Timing Chain Assembly.>
- 4) Install the front chain cover.
- <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-42, INSTALLATION, Front Chain Cover.>
- 5) Install the crank pulley. <Ref. to ME(H6DO)-41, INSTALLATION, Crank Pulley.>

C: INSPECTION

- 1) Check the crank sprocket teeth for abnormal wear and scratches.
- 2) Make sure there is no free play between crank sprocket and key.
