

4. Horn Switch

A: REMOVAL

CAUTION:

Before servicing, be sure to read the notes in the AB section for proper handling of the driver's airbag module. <Ref. to AB-6, CAUTION, General Description.>

NOTE:

Horn switch is a unit with the driver's airbag module.


- 1) Disconnect the ground cable from battery.
- 2) Remove the driver's airbag module. <Ref. to AB-17, REMOVAL, Driver's Airbag Module.>

B: INSTALLATION

Install in the reverse order of removal.

C: INSPECTION

Measure the resistance between horn switch terminal and airbag module bracket.
